
#### Who is Smartphone Dependent?


Smartphone dependency varies across age, income, and education levels. Younger, lower-income, and less-educated adults are more likely to rely on smartphones as their main internet access. These differences highlight ongoing digital divides in the U.S.

#### **Smartphone Dependency by Age**



In 2015, younger adults (18-29) were twice as likely to be smart-phone-dependent as seniors.


## **Smartphone Dependency By Household Income**
